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THEME DESCRIPTIONS

June 8th - 12th: All About Me and My Family (Self-awareness week)

During the first week of summer, we are concentrating on finding out more about ourselves and our families. We will create projects using art, writing and technology to help tell the story about ourselves and our family. At the end of the week, we will present our book/project to family and friends and get to know each other more.

June 15th - 19th: Zookeeper & Animal Superpower (Animal awareness week)

We are going to be a zookeeper, explore zoo animals and their natural habitats. Pick a favorite animal and research about your favorite animal. What is your animal's super power and favorite food? Where does your animal live? Why is it your favorite?

June 22nd - 26th: Detective Differences (Social awareness week)

This week, we are using our five senses to become a detective. While language learning consists of so many different aspects of life, we encourage our students to step back and really start paying attention about the differences between China and the United States. An open mind and observing eyes are essential for the detective job. Let's put the differences in the spotlight and build a bridge to connect and understand them.

July 13th - 17th: Cultures Around the World (Culture awareness week)

There are so many different countries and cultures in the world. We will be doing imaginary travels from one place to another to have fun. All activities and lessons are built about the country of the day. Let's imagine what our day will be like if we teleported to a completely different place and found ourselves living with a totally different culture.

THEME DESCRIPTIONS

July 20th - 24th: Hardware and Software (Technology awareness week)
